



Pennsylvania Act 153

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania now requires that hospital colleagues who have a “significant likelihood or regular contact with children in the form of care, guidance, supervision or training” obtain the following background check as a condition of employment.

As a newly hired colleague to Trinity Health Mid-Atlantic, you will be required to complete the FBI Criminal Background check and Pennsylvania Child Abuse History “Childline” child abuse clearance. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in your start date being delayed.

- You will receive a service code and next steps through your background check through First Advantage (formerly known as Sterling) for both the FBI Criminal Background check and Pennsylvania Child Abuse History “Childline” child abuse clearance.
- The fingerprint-based background check is a multi-step process.
